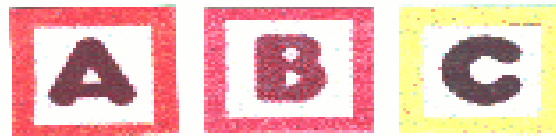


Fun Ways to Help Your Child Learn About the Alphabet



- Look at alphabet books with your child. Ask the librarian at the library to show you where these books are.
- Using play-dough can be a great way to have your child make the letters in his or her name. Making play-dough at home with your child's help is fun!
- Put shaving cream on a tray and encourage your child to use their fingers like a pencil and write letters.
- Encourage your child to play with magnetic letters on a metal cooking tray or refrigerator
- Encourage your child to draw letters on the pavement with chalk. Help them to write their name and then let them try!
- Give your child opportunities to use markers, pencils, crayons and pens and paint. Try washable markers, white erase markers, glitter pens and chalk.
